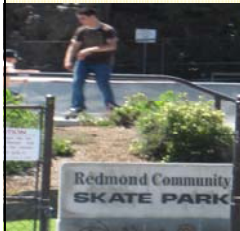

Why The City of Redmond Parks Department?

The City of Redmond until recently has been one of the fastest growing areas in the state. The City strives to be a model for other Northwest communities by being innovative in the creation of a high quality of life, ample family wage jobs and a safe environment in which to raise and educate families.

The Redmond Parks department maintains seventeen public parks with facilities that service a variety of activities including picnic, biking, fishing, skateboarding and more.

The City's longest park area is a 3.5 mile section on the Westside of town called the Dry Canyon. The canyon encompasses several city parks and a recreational trail that runs north to south.

The City of Redmond earned the 'Tree City USA' designation in 2005. Becoming a Tree City USA helped the City get started toward an annual, systematic management of its tree resources. We now have an Arborist on staff to educate about urban tree care and help confront problems associated with poorly managed and aging trees. Our Arborist is also giving input at new construction areas to create a healthy balance between development and our urban forest.

About the Region

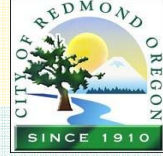
Redmond, with a population of approximately 24,000, sits at the western edge of Oregon's High Desert in Deschutes County, just four miles from the Deschutes River, a half-hour from the Cascade Mountains and within minutes of several lakes. This high desert community rests on a flat plateau at an elevation of 3,077 feet above sea level. The climate is semi-arid, with average annual precipitation of only 8.64 inches. Redmond enjoys a high percentage of sunny days throughout the year. The area has four distinct seasons, each bringing refreshingly different weather patterns.

The natural beauty that surrounds Redmond is unique in Central Oregon. This includes the world's largest stand of western juniper to the various recreational activities including camping, outstanding fly fishing, world class rock climbing at Smith Rock State Park, golf, hiking, photography and all types of winter snow sports. Recreational activities are why Redmond's quality of life rates so high.

Redmond Municipal Airport is the air carrier and commercial aviation hub of Central Oregon. The airport is served by Horizon Air, United Express, Delta Connection, Allegiant Air, Airborne Express, FedEx & UPS. Plans are underway for expansion of the terminal, improvements to taxiways, the general aviation ramp, and expansion of the terminal parking lots.
