

CITY OF REDMOND CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Dry Canyon Trail SW Pumice Stairs



Construction Cost: \$86,186

Contractor: Key Constructors, Inc.

Funding : Oregon Department of Transportation Flex Funds and City of Redmond Transportation Funds.

Completion: May 31, 2012

Reasons for the project:

The SW Pumice stairs and trail provide another connection between the Dry Canyon Trail and adjacent neighborhoods. The existing footpath from SW Pumice descends a steep, rocky slope. The new path and stairs will provide a safer, easier to use connection to the 3.8 mile Dry Canyon trail which extends from SW Quartz to the north edge of Redmond.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

A trail will be constructed connecting SW Pumice Avenue and SW 21st Street to the Dry Canyon trail. Most of the trail will be a 10 foot wide asphalt path, but there will also be a set of concrete steps at the steep edge of the canyon. The stairs will be similar to those recently constructed at SW Obsidian.

The project also includes intersection improvements at SW Pumice and SW 21st Street. Sidewalk and curb will be constructed along the east and north sides of the intersection with a curb ramp and driveways to two houses on the north side of Pumice. Pavement will be widened and the mailboxes relocated not far from their current location. The drawings on the following page shows these improvements.

Most of the construction will not impact the street, but there will be temporary access impacts when the driveways are built.

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
